The Science Department is delighted to announce that registrations are now open for the **National Standard Examinations (NSE) – 2026**, conducted by the **Indian Association of Physics Teachers (IAPT)** under the National Olympiad Programme.

The National Standard Examinations are among India's most prestigious Science Olympiad examinations and provide an excellent opportunity for scientifically inclined students to demonstrate their conceptual understanding, analytical reasoning, and problem-solving skills. These examinations serve as the **first stage of the Olympiad Programme**, through which meritorious students may progress to higher national-level stages and eventually represent India in the **International Olympiads**.

Eligible students may register for the following examinations:

- NSEP – National Standard Examination in Physics
- NSEC – National Standard Examination in Chemistry
- NSEB – National Standard Examination in Biology
- NSEA – National Standard Examination in Astronomy
- NSEJS – National Standard Examination in Junior Science

## Why should you participate?

Participation in the NSE will help you:

- Enhance your conceptual understanding of Science beyond the classroom.
- Develop logical reasoning and scientific aptitude.
- Build confidence for competitive examinations such as **JEE, NEET, IISER Aptitude Test**, and other national-level entrance examinations.

- Earn recognition and certificates for outstanding performance.
- Take the first step towards representing India in International Science Olympiads.

## Eligibility criteria:

- For NSEP; NSEC; NSEB and NSEA: Any student of class 12, 11 or 10 on **30.11.2026** and born between **01.07.2007** and **30.06.2012** both days inclusive.
- Syllabus up to Class 12 CBSE India.
- For NSEJS: Any student of class 10, 9 or 8 on **30.11.2026** and born between **01.01.2012** to **31.12.2013** both days inclusive.
- Syllabus Physics, Chemistry and Biology up to Class 10 CBSE India
